



Effective January 7, 2026, Community Advocates will pause accepting new applications for direct rental assistance due to limited funding available.

Exceptions- Tenants are eligible to apply if they are facing the following:

- A placard
- Fire or domestic violence situation
- Residency in a Zilber Family Foundation Initiative Neighborhood:
 - Lindsay Heights
 - Clarke Square
 - Layton Boulevard West

The **Milwaukee Rental Housing Resource Center** will continue to offer assessment and eviction prevention resources, including referrals for mediation, conditions issues and case management.
