

Acceptable Documents to Show Proof of Financial Hardship

You will be asked to show proof of the financial hardship you have experienced due directly or indirectly to the Covid-19 pandemic. The following chart tells you what forms of documents we accept for proof, depending on what type of hardship you've experienced.

Income Loss/Reduction	Acceptable Documentation
Lost Employment	 Unemployment Compensation Statement (Note: this satisfies the proof of income requirement as well.) Termination/Furlough letter from Employer Pay stub from previous employer with indication that the place of employment has closed
Hours Reduced	 Wage statements showing a reduction in hours and pay Letter from the Employer
Applicant or other adult in household not working in order to supervise virtual learning	Verification of children's school enrollment
Household expenses incurred	 Receipts from relocation expenses and rental fees, reasonably incurred late fees, internet service, medical bills
