Batterers' Prevention and Intervention Program

Nevermore Batterers Prevention and Intervention Program, part of Community Advocates' Milwaukee Women's Center division, aims to end and prevent intimate partner violence by addressing the motivations and behaviors of men who are physically, sexually, and/or emotionally abusive with their partner or children. Through intensive group and individual sessions, counselors help clients to learn the core values of respect and personal responsibility with the goal of stopping their violent or abusive behavior in all forms.

The Nevermore Program includes:

- 23-33 group sessions for first-time participants, plus individual counseling and art therapy
- Programming at Community Advocates' Downtown Milwaukee and Fond du lac Avenue offices
- A zero-tolerance maintenance group for Nevermore graduates
- Alcohol and other drug (AODA) individual and group sessions
- Referrals to the Milwaukee Fatherhood FIRE program at Community Advocates
- Home and office visits with clients and probation and parole agents
- Intervention and prevention services for adult and young men in same-sex relationships
- Access to Community Advocates' support services, such as housing assistance, job training, energy assistance, and case management services
- Enrollment is accepted by appointment and referral.
